

Safety & Environmental Protection Policy

Algoma Tankers Limited is a wholly owned subsidiary of Algoma Central Corporation with the primary function of providing transportation of liquid petroleum and chemical products throughout the Great Lakes, St. Lawrence Waterway and East Coast Regions.

Algoma strives to be an exemplary leader in safety and environmental management, and is committed to the protection of the environment; particularly the marine environment, the prevention of human injury and loss of life and the protection of property.

To achieve and sustain these goals our operations are guided by the following seven basic principles:

Management, operating, maintenance, health, safety and emergency response practices will be conducted in accordance with documented procedures that meet or exceed the highest national and international standards for the marine industry and ensure compliance with all applicable regulations and legislation.

Risks to the safety of ships, health of employees and preservation of the environment, will be constantly evaluated and managed.

Specific resources will be dedicated to the continual management of safety, health and environmental protection programs, and communication and co-operation in that respect with government agencies, customers and industry associations.

All management systems will be subject to periodic internal and external audits, with specific emphasis on health, safety and environmental protection.

New projects will be evaluated for potential risks to employees, customers, the general public and the environment.

Education and training will ensure that personnel familiarize themselves with all applicable procedures and conduct themselves conscientiously with respect to health, safety and environmental protection.

Safety and environmental management will be subject to regular review by the Environmental Health & Safety Committee of Algoma Central Corporation.
